THE HOTEL DEL CORONADO

A National Historical Landmark

A guest speaker/Hotel del docent will share lots of history of San Diego's famous beachfront resort, THE HOTEL DEL CORONADO. When the hotel opened in 1888, it was the largest elegant resort hotel in the world. Even in the 1890's the famous hotel assisted with the San Diego ecomony, receiving special recognition with visitors nation wide and world wide. It has hosted presidents, royalty, and celebrities and has been featured in numerous films and books.

An American architectural gem--the Victorian beach resort was designated a California Historic Landmark in 1977. It is the second largest wooden structure in the United States (after the Tillamook Air Museum in Tillamook, Oregon).

In 1885 a group of five investors bought the uninhabited Coronado and North Island, about 4,000 acres -- a wasteland that had no road or ferry access, no water or electricity, and no lumber or laborers. Interestingly, the landscaping for the hotel was completed by Kate Sessions, who also helped landscape San Diego's Balboa Park.

Hope you can attend to hear about the many firsts involved in the planning and building of this "JEWEL HOTEL IN SAN DIEGO."
