Hotel Del, built to appeal to travelers from the East and Midwest, opened in 1888, when travel over long distances had to be done by rail. Much of the country between California and the Midwest was still unsettled at that time, so people relied on trains to come here from the large population centers in

Advisor(s): Rita Johnson, Past President the East and Midwest. The builders of the Hotel, Mr. Babcock and Mr. Story, arranged for trains to come directly to Coronado, so that tourists could enjoy the beautiful new hotel and its location on the ocean shore.

When Hotel del Coronado opened in 1888 it was considered a technological marvel. Electricity was still a novelty in 1888, and The Del was thought to be one of the largest buildings in the country to have been "electrified." In 1904, The Del made history when it unveiled the world's first electrically lit, outdoor, living Christmas tree.

Over the years, the hotel has entertained many celebrities, Presidents of the United States, politicians, and notable individuals. The hotel has been a sought-after setting for filmmakers, as well. One of the most popular early films that used The Del as its backdrop was "The Pearl of Paradise," starring Margarita Fischer. Later, Marilyn Monroe, Tony Curtis, and Jack Lemon frolicked at the hotel in "Some Like It Hot."

The hotel is undergoing some major repairs, a project that already has taken five years and will be completed in 2025, at a cost of more than \$160 million, focusing on the rebuilding of the main part of the hotel. Meanwhile, accommodations are being offered in other parts of the Del complex, so visitors can still enjoy the beach, shops, and lobby, as well as the dining offerings, pools, museum, and fitness center. So, if you have a chance, stop by for a Sunday brunch, even if you cannot stay longer. This is the finest of San Diego and we should all take advantage of the opportunity to appreciate it!
