



Soon after, I ended my year-long contract and also returned to San Diego. Butch and I got married on August 16, 1957. Butch worked in the air conditioning field, creating his own very successful company. We had a beautiful life together, enjoying our family and traveling. Our last trip was in 2008 - a 103-day cruise around the world. It was fantastic! We had been married 59 years when Butch passed away on October 23, 2016.
