"Backstage at The Old Globe Theatre"

Presentation by Danielle Mages Amato, Ph.D.


We were pleased to have Danielle Mages Amato, Ph.D., the Literary Manager and Dramaturge at The Old Globe Theatre in San Diego, come and speak at our Wed. Etc. Luncheon on Wednesday, October 10th, held at the Bernardo Heights Country Club. Danielle holds a MFA in Dramaturgy and a Ph.D. in Drama and Theatre from the University of California, San Diego (UCSD).

Danielle Amato gave a delightful and enthusiastic presentation about the history of The Old Globe Theatre, which was built in 1935 as a replica of the Shakespearean Globe Theatre in London. However, the original Old Globe Theatre in San Diego burned down in 1978, but was soon rebuilt, and has become a historical 250-seat theatre-in-the-round. There is also a 600-seat outdoor stage, which was built after the fire.

Danielle talked about how a play or musical is written and adapted to the stage, with a detailed description of their most successful musical show this year, "Alliance," with photos of each planning step -- from gathering play-writers, directors, producers, stage scenery, actors & singers, writing the music and orchestrations, and special costumes. "The Heart of Rock & Roll" musical is playing now and is highly recommended! Public Tours are also given every Saturday morning. Danielle ended her talk with questions from the audience.

A delicious luncheon of Salmon Salad or Quiche Lorraine with Apple Cobbler for dessert was enjoyed by all the members and guests.
