## What Do You Think?

Our most interesting member, Paula Cobb, has an

exciting experience to share -- gaining a new niece thanks to DNA testing! Here is her special story:

My four daughters and I went to the Cheesecake Factory in late February to celebrate three of their birthdays and to share the results of our DNA tests. While we were there, my oldest daughter signed on to Ancestry.com. When she did this, a name of a girl popped up on her site and the site said that this girl,

named Stacia, was a first cousin. We didn't know how this was possible, because in order to be a first cousin, this girl would have to be my brother's daughter! So we were all very curious.

My daughter looked up this girl on Facebook Messenger and found her. She contacted Stacia and asked her where she was born. Stacia said she was born in Ohio and was given up at birth through the Children's Home Society. By this point, my hair was standing up on my arms! She gave her date of birth and that date coincided with the time period when my brother was seeing a really cute girl during high school. Stacia said she didn't know much about her parents. The only thing she knew about them was a description of what they looked like. She had been told that the father was 5'9" tall, 165 lbs., with light brown hair and blue eyes. My hair stood up on my arms again as I realized this described my brother to a tee! Then they described the mother as a 98 lb., 5' tall, blonde. As soon as I heard her description. I knew that was the girl my brother had dated and fallen in love with during high school.

The next day we contacted my brother and told him what we had discovered. He was very surprised, but at the same time, he was happy thinking that he might have another daughter. He said the timing was right, as it fit with his going away to college, when his girlfriend would have been a senior in high school. In thinking back, my brother remembered that his girlfriend's father came over to our house and told him not to see his daughter again. He said if he tried to see her, he would get a

restraining order against him. But he never said why he was acting that way. So, my brother just went off to college and forgot about it. So, now, all these years later, he knows why the father was so upset! In those days, if a girl got pregnant, it wasn't looked upon very favorably by society. Families usually just sent the mother away to have the child and give the child up for adoption, and it was never spoken of again, which is exactly what happened here.

Subsequently, my brother submitted his own DNA test, and Stacia showed up on his results as his daughter. He is 74 and she is 56, and they are just starting to have a relationship. He has met her family and he spent Father's Day with her. I met her as well, when I was back in Ohio for a family reunion. My brother wants the rest of the family to meet her, too. We all have so much catching up to do! She is such a wonderful sweet girl, and we are all so happy to finally know each other. She has grown up all these years less than 30 minutes from my brother! And she went to school with several of our cousins and they all knew each other; they just didn't know they were related. The birth mother has been told that we all know about this daughter. She lives within 30 minutes of everyone as well. I think she is still in shock and probably cannot believe her secret was found out. She is not ready at this time to meet her daughter, but in time, my brother thinks she will come around.
